## Senior Citizen Low Income Utility Discount Eligibility Requirements

To qualify for the City of Bothell Senior Citizen Low Income Utility Discount the applicant **MUST MEET ALL 3** of the following criteria and supply the proper documentation to the Finance Department:

**1) AGE** - Applicant must be 62 years or older at the time of application.

**Any of the following are proof of age:**

- Birth certificate
- Driver's license
- Washington State identification card
- Social Security statement

**2) RESIDENCE & OWNERSHIP** - Applicant must own and reside in their home which is located within the city limits of Bothell.

**Proof of residency would include the following:**

- Copies of utility bills
- Driver's license

**Proof of home ownership would include the following:**

- County real estate tax bill or tax assessment statement
- Copy of signed tax return for the prior year showing itemized deduction for real estate taxes

**3) INCOME** - Applicant's annual income level must not exceed the Federal Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Department "very low income" level based on the number of people in the household based on their PMSA/MSA chart for King and Snohomish Counties as follows:
