The Planning Commission will consider code amendments regarding **Limited Parking Reductions & Height Allowances** on July 15th. The potential parking amendments are necessary to comply with State requirements regarding minimum parking requirements near frequent transit service. The potential height allowance amendments would permit an additional floor of affordable housing within the originally studied height limit in feet in certain Downtown Subarea districts.
