A right of way permit is required for the temporary placement of pods/storage containers in the City right of way, associated with multi-family and commercial developments. Single family residentially zoned areas allow pods and storage containers on private property only. Allow up to one week for processing.

- To maintain safe lines of sight, place the container at least 30 ft away from intersections and 10 ft away from driveways and hydrants
- The container company may need specific clearances for delivery, make sure to confirm the space needed for delivery with the container company
- No fee for permit
- Allow up to one week for processing

To the extent any of the damages referenced by this paragraph were caused by or resulted from the concurrent negligence of the City, its agents or employees, this obligation to indemnify, defend and hold harmless is valid and enforceable only to the extent of the negligence of the applicant, his officers, agents and employees.
