

Bothell High School Sophomores Learn to “Think Again”

Friday June 12th, Firefighter Kirk Robinson and Firefighter Jason Emerson spent the day at Bothell High School teaching students the dangers of drinking and driving and the importance of seatbelt use. Firefighters provide real-life stories about motor vehicle crashes they have witnessed and answer student’s tough questions in a small group environment where each student can have safe access to quality emergency response information.
